Yes! it was a very satisfying first year for IIST. We completed our first academic year (2007-2008) successfully with a wide variety of curricular and extra curricular activities. A well structured curriculum for the second semester was introduced and the novel feature was the conduct of real life practical experiments using VSSC facilities for students, which was an exciting experience for students. This second news letter will cover most of our activities during second semester which began on 4th March 2008 and ended on 30th June 2008.

We started the second semester by inaugurating a sports complex in the campus with Volleyball court, Cricket net practicing pitch and a shuttle court. We conducted regular matches among intra houses and IIST's first sports day was organized on 5th May 2008. Similarly greater impetus was given to cultural and literary activities. Detailed report on sport, literary and cultural activities involving IIST students and faculty are reported elsewhere in this news letter. The first ever IIST annual day was celebrated on 5th June and our Chairman was the chief guest. It was an excellent opportunity for our students and faculty to exhibit their talents.

On the academic front I am happy to inform you that eminent personalities like Wing Commander Rakesh Sharma (the first Indian to go to space), Roddam Narasimha (JNCASR), Prof. U R Rao (Former Chairman, ISRO) and Prof. Yashpal (Former UGC Chairman) visited the Institute, interacted with faculty and students and gave very interesting and educative talks. They also provided very valuable suggestions to improve the academic curriculum of the Institute.

We have initiated the necessary actions to initiate M. Tech courses on certain specific disciplines which are of interest to ISRO. We are also in the process of registering a selected few from ISRO centres for Ph. D courses at IIST. A major thrust was given to research activities by setting up a research board with Dr. Adimurthy as Chairman. A few proposals from faculties are already under process. More faculty members have joined in various departments and we have now Mr. Vasudevan, IFS (Indian Forest Service) as our Registrar. Compared with the first semester, IIST students have improved considerably in their academic performance in the second semester.

I take this opportunity to record my sincere thanks to each and every one who has made valuable contribution in building this Institute and convey my warm greetings and best wishes to all readers of this newsletter.

### **Seminar Series**

Every, Wednesday at 17.00 hrs, seminars are regularly organized at IIST. On these days, IIST students give seminars on various topics and once a month, eminent personalities are invited to for special lectures.

From April to June 2008, students gave seminars on variety of topics which are of interest to students and faculty. Nitin Kumar Mishra, (Aero), Prakhar Agarwal (Aero), Kanav Setia (Aero), Dhinesh Dhankar, (Avionics), Shomil Saxena(Avionics), and Umang Kumar Rathi(Aero) delivered seminars on topics like Space Physics (Solar winds and Sun Spots, Time Travel), Galaxies, Indian Scientific Heritage, Mountaineering, Flying Wind Mills etc.

### Rakesh Sharma (First Indian to go to space)

IIST was fortunate to have some of the eminent personalities delivering lectures and interacting with students during the second semester. The first Indian to go to space, Shri Rakesh Sharma was the first to visit IIST and interact with students. Abhinav, Tejeswita and Pradeep interviewed him on his experiences in space. (Details of this interview is published in IIST's in house magazine Dhrishtik on (Vol. 1 No.1). Later, Shri Rakesh Sharma addressed the students and faculty of IIST along with VSSC scientists.

### Prof. Roddam Narasimha (Eminent Fluid Dynamist)

On May 14th, 2007, Prof Roddam Narasimha, one of India's greatest Fluid Dynamists who inspired many at India's prestigious IISC (Indian Institute of Science) for several decades visited IIST. He interacted with the faculty of IIST discussing the credit system and how to lift underperforming students etc. in detail. He then gave an excellent talk on "The Science and Technology of Fluid Flows" followed by intense interaction with IIST students for almost about an hour.

### Prof. U R Rao (Former ISRO's Chairman)

Prof. U R Rao, one of India's greatest space scientists and former Chairman of ISRO who inspired ISRO's young scientists for several decades, visited IIST on 4th June 2008. His presence at IIST was very inspiring and IIST used this opportunity to interact with him. True to his stature Prof. U R Rao delivered a very interesting talk on "Exciting Ten Challenges in Space" for IIST's young students, who have opted for a career in ISRO.

### Prof. R Natarajan (Former Director, IIT Madras)

On I I th June 2008, Prof. R Natarajan, former Director of IIT Madras and Chairman AICTE visited IIST along with Prof. Yashpal. Prof. Natarajan later delivered a talk at VSSC auditorium and interacted with IIST faculty on curriculum and credits.

### Prof. Yashpal (Former UGC Chairman)

Prof. Yashpal's visit to IIST was really a great turning point to our seminar series. Prof. Yashpal, apart from his outstanding contributions to academics as UGC Chairman, Astrophysicist at TIFR or Director SAC, really inspired not only willing students but also unwilling common people in India through his simple explanations. Who can forget his innings at TURNING POINT on TV? IIST was really very fortunate to have him for several hours interacting freely with students and faculty on 11th June 2008. Prof. Yashpal while interacting with IIST faculty explained the various aspects of the Indian education system. Prof. Yashpal answered a variety of questions put forward by IIST students in both Hindi and English effortlessly with his usual humor.
