Experimental Facility at IIST Ponmudi Climate Observatory

IIST has established a Climate Observatory at its Ponmudi Campus on the hilltop of the Western Ghats (PCO, 8.76°N, 77.12°E, 1 km, AMSL). It is equipped with state-of-the-art field instrumentation for measuring aerosol and cloud microphysics and meteorological variables. These instruments are also extensively used for lab and teaching courses at IIST.

Monthly balloon launches for the measurement of the vertical profile of ozone along with meteorological parameters have also been initiated under the coordination and support of the National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC), Hyderabad. The observatory has a provision for the Tethered balloon launch with a payload carrying capacity of 3 kg up to 1 km.

Academic Visit to SPL, VSSC

A one-day academic field visit to SPL Labs and VSSC Facilities for M. Tech, Ph.D. students of the Department of Earth and Space Sciences, IIST, was conducted on 10th March 2023. On this occasion, experts scientist from each Lab and Facility explained various state-of-the-art instrumentation commissioned in the TELRS area for surface (aerosols, clouds) and boundary layer observations, including the Met facility and Doppler Weather Radar (DWR) facility. English Language Support Programme

Dr. Mackenzie Bristow from the University of Emory visited IIST campus on 16-01-23 as part of the English Language Support Programme offered by the Regional English Language Office of the US Embassy. The six weeks' piloted teaching programme consisted of modules in Technical Writing for B. Tech First Semester students and Research Writing programme for M. Tech and Ph D scholars. Dr. Bristow, with her pilot courses, employed problem-solving and critical thinking to a variety of daily and academic tasks with varying levels of linguistic difficulty, identified individualized target areas to focus on for improvement in speaking, engaged in topics related to space science with a focus on speaking skills, applied sentence-level cohesive strategies to comprehend and speak in paragraph discourse, demonstrated appropriate use of thought groups, focus words, and body language in rehearsed speech tasks, employed self-monitoring

techniques to speak with correct word endings and verb tense and helped with vocabulary related to students' field-specific interests and course material.

Five Week Course in Research Article Writing for Research Scholars

Dr. Bristow took sessions across the 5 weeks for Technical Writing including sending email, while thrusting on the English for specific purposes and task-based language learning to enhance the students' language development.

She also took sessions for the PhD scholars to facilitate academic writing, fundamentals of peer review and revising, summarizing and paraphrasing techniques and online and corpus-based tools to improve written mechanics and grammar.

National Level Workshop on Electric Aircraft and Allied Technologies

The second National Level Workshop on Electric Aircraft and Allied Technologies was held at CSIR-NAL, Bengaluru on 27-28 April, 2023. The workshop was organized jointly by CSIR-NAL, Design Division AeSI, IIST and Society of Indian Aerospace Technologies and Industries (SIATI). The welcome note and proceedings was given by Dr. Abhay Pashilkar (Director, CSIR-NAL) followed by Dr. Kota Harinarayana explaining about the importance of the workshop on Electric aircraft and its allied technologies. Dr Kalai Selvi, DG, CSIR

presented the keynote address and stressed on the importance of Electric Mobility in terms of actuators, controllers, powertrain, Batteries, Battery management system, Fuel cells etc. She mentioned that the workshop aims to discuss how best to electrify aircraft and the allied technologies involved. The team consisting of CSIR-NAL, VSSC and IIST plan to start work with electrification of two-seater Hansa-NG aircraft and subsequently take up work related to larger passenger aircraft.

Workshop on “Executive Program in Social Science Research Methodology”

A three-day workshop on “Executive Program in Social Science Research Methodology” was conducted from 9 May 2023 to 11 May 2023. The program dealt with cutting edge tools in the field of social science research such as Instrument Variable analysis, Randomised Control Trials (RCTs) and Difference-in-differences analysis, among others. It had active participation from educational institutions across India including Centre for Development Studies (CDS), BITS Pilani, NIT, Goa, Gulati Institute of Finance and Taxation (GIFT), University of Kerala and Calicut University. There were about 30 participants from different regions of India including Kashmir, Odisha, Jharkhand, Delhi, Goa, Bengal, Andhra Pradesh and Kerala, pursuing research on disciplines

encompassing Economics, Sociology, Education, Political Science and Management.

Workshop on International Research Grant Writing

A workshop on international research grant writing titled 'How to write your first international grant proposal?' was conducted on 11 May 2023 from 2 pm to 4 pm. The workshop introduced the participants to various international research grant programs including United Kingdom Research and Innovation (UKRI), Nuffield Foundation Grants, Global Innovation Fund and Commonwealth Local Government Good Practice Scheme etc. It also

shared meaningful insights on why apply for a grant, how to apply for a grant, how funding works and tips for grant writing. There was an enthusiastic participation of about 70 students from IIST and educational institutions across India including Centre for Development Studies (CDS), BITS Pilani, NIT, Goa, Gulati Institute of Finance and Taxation (GIFT), University of Kerala and Calicut University.



Hands-on Training

The research scholars of the Department of Humanities, IIST were given hands-on training of Stata, a multi-purpose statistical software package

for data manipulation, visualization and automated reporting, on 12 May 2023.

Academic Collaborations

Discussions on possible academic collaborations between IIST and Newcastle University, UK were held with faculty as well as students from 12 May 2023 to 15 May 2023. The possibilities of cutting edge interdisciplinary research spanning different

disciplines including Economics, Earth and Space Sciences and Spatial Engineering were deliberated.

Screening of Documentaries

As part of AAG (Academic Assistance Group) of Dept of Humanities organised screening & discussion of the National Award winning Documentary “The Lord of the Universe” and “The Motherland” directed by Shri. Shibu Prusty, Sr. Tech. Asst A (videography), DECU and Research Scholar, at Dept of Humanities. The documentaries were screened on 19th May 2023 and 9th June 2023 respectively in the Audio Visual Lab for the students and staff of IIST.



Class on Research Methodology

A Research Methodology class for Cultural Studies Research Scholars was conducted online on 15th June 2023 under the guidance of Dr. Aneesh T. V, Assistant Professor at the Department of Social work, Aditi Mahavidyalaya, University of Delhi. Purpose of the session was to provide students with the necessary knowledge and skills to

undertake rigorous research within the field of Cultural Studies. By familiarizing them with various research approaches, methods, and techniques, the class aimed to equip students with the tools they need to engage in meaningful interdisciplinary research.


